Onward in Faith: GO ALL IN!

Last fall Campus Lutheran began a formal process of stewardship education and spiritual renewal called: *Onward in Faith*. At the heart of the *Onward in Faith* initiative is the Biblical concept that we are called to be faithful stewards—caretakers and managers—of all that we are given. Once a person is baptized, they inherit all the blessings and resources of the Kingdom of God, and from that moment on are to use everything to the glory of the Lord.

During the educational phase of *Onward in Faith* we applied Biblical stewardship principles to topics relating to identity, meaning, calling and accountability. We looked at how we value and care for our relationship with God, our understanding of who we are as children

of God, and how we are to value and care for other people. We talked about our responsibility to care for creation. And we learned what God's Word teaches us about stewarding our relationship with money so that it accomplishes God's purposes.

In March, we will begin the "custom" phase of *Onward in Faith*. During this phase we will begin to apply what we've learned to our congregation. We have been gathered around Word and Sacrament to accomplish the Lord's work together. *But what does this mean*? The Scriptures teach us that we have been entrusted with the purpose of carrying out Christ's mission on earth. During March and April we will be encouraging the members of Campus Lutheran to "GO ALL IN" and recognize more clearly our mission, vision and purpose as faithful stewards who serve our community in the name of Christ. The custom phase will culminate with a special "Commitment Celebration" on Sunday, April 24.

Our GO ALL IN journey will officially begin on **March 6**, the first Sunday in Lent. All of our Lenten services this year will follow the GO ALL IN theme, as we recall how Christ, our Lord, went "all in" for us—giving His life in exchange for ours so we could receive a new and everlasting life in His name!

As we go along this journey together, we're asking you to participate in a 4-session study called "Launch." Launch will help each of us grow in our knowledge of Campus Lutheran and its ministries, our own spiritual gifts, what it means to be a follower of Christ, and to discover specific ways that God has prepared for us to serve Him. The Launch sessions will be offered at various times by a number of facilitators, so hopefully everyone will find a time when they can participate. More detailed information will be coming soon, but please don't hesitate to reach out to me or one of our *Onward in Faith* leaders if you have questions!






