CREATED TO CONNECT (FELLOWSHIP + COMMUNITY) :: We come together as a loving family in Christ, fostering meaningful relationships among God's people. Through fellowship, care, encouragement, and hospitality, we build intergenerational and cross-cultural community that reflects the love of Jesus.
