

# Easter Sunday at Campus Lutheran

New guidelines from local authorities concerning public gatherings have allowed us to slightly change our registration and attendance procedures to accommodate more people. Please read the following information so that you will know what to expect if you attend worship services on Easter Sunday at Campus Lutheran.

## Want a Guaranteed Sanctuary Seat? Consider the 11:00 am Service

The content of our 8:30am service and our 11:00am service will be **identical**, except that the choir will sing in the 8:30am service only. There are still guaranteed sanctuary seats available for registration, which you can get by visiting [campuslutheran.org/worship](https://campuslutheran.org/worship) or by calling the church office.

## Are you registered for Guaranteed Sanctuary Seating? Read this!

If you registered online or on the phone and have guaranteed sanctuary seating, you should arrive at church and be seated at least fifteen minutes before the start of the service. After that time, we will begin seating people who are not registered.

When you arrive, you'll be checked in by one of the greeters. When you're checked in, you'll be given a check-in slip for each person in your party that is registered. You'll proceed to the sanctuary and will hand your check-in slips to an usher, who will direct you to your seat. For Easter Sunday only, because we are trying to accommodate the maximum number of people while still maintaining social distancing guidelines, we ask that you **allow the ushers to seat you**.

## Did you miss out on registration for Guaranteed Sanctuary Seating?

If you do not have a registration, a "queue" will open one hour before the service start time. To "queue," simply arrive at church once the queue opens, and numbered queue slips will be given out on a first-come, first-served basis. Once you receive a queue slip, you can wait in the Community Life Center. Fifteen minutes before the service begins, we will begin seating people in the order of their queue slip numbers. You will be seated in overflow seating that may be in the narthex, the fireside/connect room, or the sanctuary. Because we are trying to accommodate the maximum number of people while still maintaining social distancing, we ask you to **allow the ushers to seat you**.

Please note that a queue number does not guarantee attendance at a worship service, but we will do our best to seat as many people with queue slips as we are able while still maintaining social distancing standards. Once we have seated as many people as possible, any remaining people wishing to attend will be directed to the **student center classroom**, where the service will be live streamed.

## Face Coverings

Face coverings that cover the nose and mouth must be worn **at all times** while inside the building. Please do not remove your mask except to consume the elements of Holy Communion.
