

SHARED MINISTRY PRAYER ITINERARY (September thru December)

Please join the Shared Ministry Prayer Group in prayers offered each Wednesday at 8:00 pm during the regular Zoom meeting. If you cannot join the [Zoom meeting](#), please stop and pray during that time each week using the prayer itinerary for each month as shown below:

September - Harvest and Farmers

Give thanks to the Lord, our Bountiful Creator for the food and the abundance of the harvest season. Pray for God's blessing on those who grow, harvest, and prepare our food. Pray that God would give us reverence for all that He has given us and make us generous and wise stewards of the things that we enjoy.

October – Pastors and Church Workers

Give thanks to God for sending our pastors and church workers to shepherd the church. Ask for God's blessing, protection and guidance for them. Pray that God will help them perform their duties well and lead balanced lives.

November – Thanksgiving for Blessings

Give thanks for the beauty of the world, the wonder of life, and the blessings of family and friends. Praise God for His goodness, mercy, and truth. Ask God to make us good stewards of His gifts and to enable us to share them richly with others.

December – The Weeks of Advent

Pray that God would come into our hearts to make this season of Advent one that welcomes Him more deeply into our lives.

Week 1 – Hope: Remember that Jesus is the hope in this messy world. Ask Jesus to help us slow down, to listen to His voice, and to focus on what is really important. We place our hope in Jesus and we prepare to celebrate His birth.

Week 2 – Peace: Remember that Jesus is the Prince of Peace, and that regardless of our circumstances He offers us peace that surpasses all human understanding. Pray that God would remove the things that hinder us from receiving Christ with joy.

Week 3 – Joy: Ask that God would help us look forward to the birth of Christ and experience the joy of salvation and celebrate that feast with love and thanksgiving.

Week 4 – Love: Ask God to help us love Him above all things. Ask that God enable us to love others, even those who are difficult to love, with joy, peace, mercy, and generosity.

Each Week:

Pray for the shared ministry partnership between Campus Lutheran Church and Good Shepherd Lutheran Church that the Holy Spirit would guide us to share the transforming love of Christ through our ministries.
